

What is a Health Home?

- It is a Free Service included in your health care benefits. A Health Home Care Coordinator can help you understand and manage your health conditions by working with you to create a care plan that meets all your social, physical, and mental health needs.

How can a Health Home help me?

With the *Health Home Services Program*, you will be assigned a Care Coordinator that will work with your medical and behavioral health care providers to ensure that your individual needs are being met.

For example, the Care Coordinator can:

- Work with your PCP, specialist or behavioral provider to obtain timely appointments, medication adjustments or refills, prescriptions for durable medical equipment, personal care aides and other services as needed.
- Assist you in applying for and obtaining financial assistance, navigating the criminal justice system as well as housing and employment services.

Who is eligible to sign-up?

- One single qualifying condition: HIV/AIDS or a Serious Mental Illness (SMI)
- Two or more chronic conditions like:
 - Substance abuse,
 - Heart disease,
 - Diabetes,
 - Asthma,
 - Hypertension
 - Overweight (BMI of 25).
